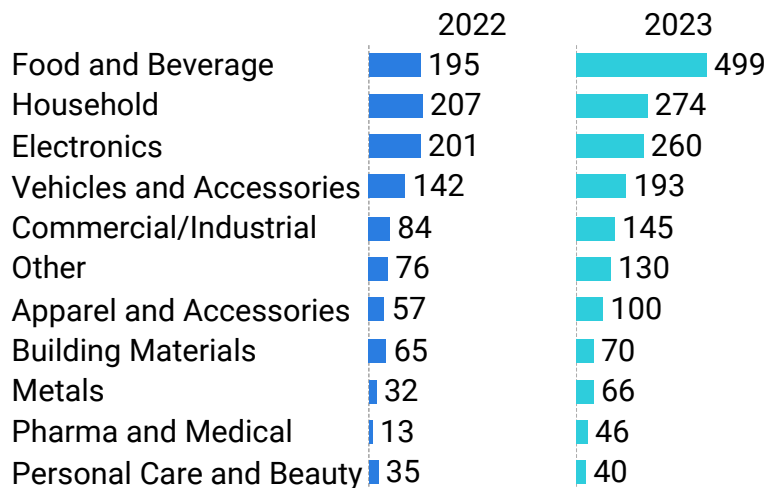

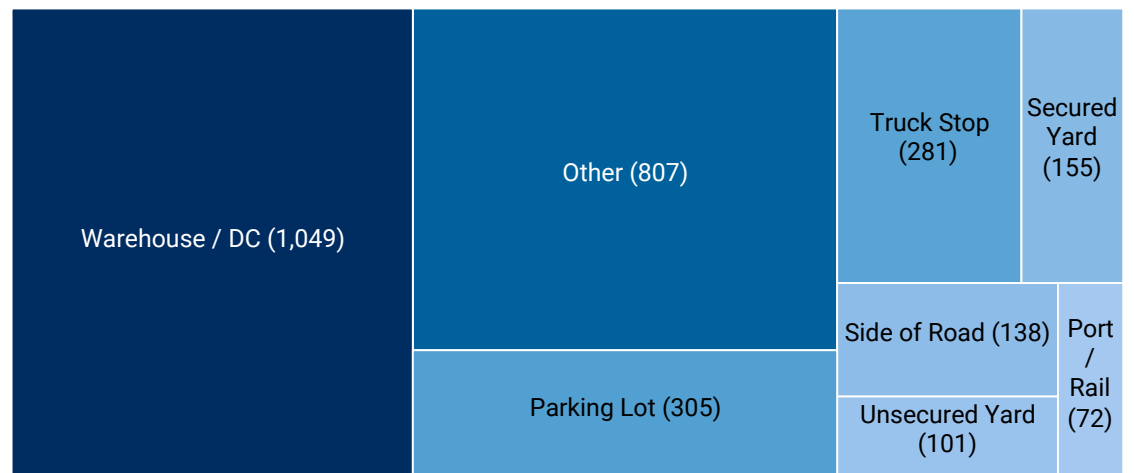

2023 Location Classification

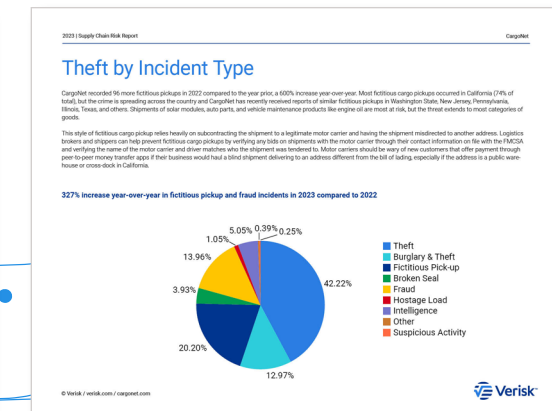
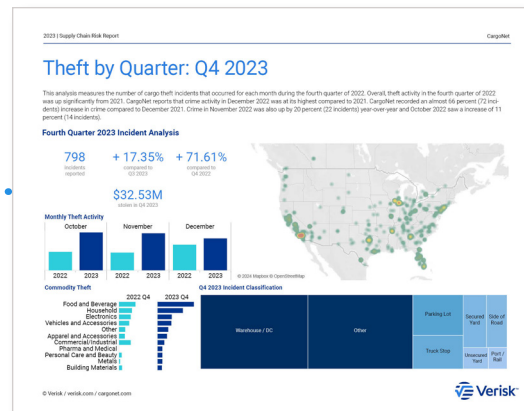
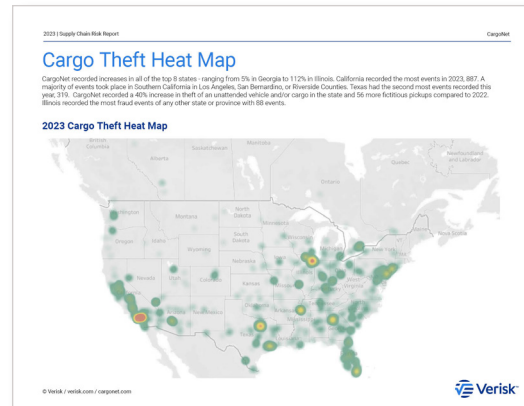


Complete 2023 Supply Chain Risk Report is Available

The 2023 Supply Chain Risk Report provides a snapshot of cargo theft during the time period between January 1, 2023 and December 31, 2023. You will find information on stolen commodity type, theft incident location and date, cargo origin/destination and loss value, as well as additional analysis generated from 144 specific data fields. The information in this report can be used to measure supply chain security risks, especially with regards to over-the-road transportation. Topics in the report include:
